A key component of Golden Star's resettlement projects is the programs to enhance livelihoods and standards of living of displaced persons. Livelihoods programs are designed to enhance income streams to families, but also seek to establish new markets, and vibrant local economies, and diversify local 'industry'.

In 2018 we continued a range of livelihood enhancement programs including piggery, grass cutter, poultry, cocoa and others. To ensure sustainability, these programs are designed following needs analysis and market research. Small business trainees are supported through apprenticeships in established businesses, extension support and small business capacity development. Recipients are encouraged to establish farmer business groups. Post-resettlement monitoring ensures recipients have capacity to ensure business resilience for sustainability and growth!
